Christmas Day saw a slightly smaller congregation (!), but again were moved by the joy of the story of the birth of Christ – Emmanuel – God with us. We are now looking forward to our Christingle Service on January 28th which will close the church's Christmas season.

It has not been the easiest of times as Sue had a fall early in December and broke a bone in her shoulder and then Jo caught Covid just before Christmas. Other members of the congregation were also unwell, and needed our prayers. The church owes an enormous debt of gratitude to Gerry who carried on solo – except not solo because others stepped up to the plate, some giving up their own arrangements to help out, and we are so thankful for all that they did. The church family by pulling together to make sure it all happened ensured we were able to join with all the other churches in the town celebrating the birth of our Lord.

This month the PCC will meet for our Section 11 meeting which is part of the formal process of recruitment, which can then start going forward. We have nearly completed our Parish Profile, which with the addition of some wonderful photographs taken by Michael Edwards gives a good picture of who we are and where we might want to go!
